Our family is getting settled in Los Barrios, right at the center of the Campo de Gibraltar region, what for millennia was the end of the known world. History is under every rock here, from the Pillars of Hercules, to the Roman temples of Carteya and Baelo Claudio to the many maritime fortifications around biblical Tarshish. We recently noticed 20th century bunkers built into the hillside while driving outside the new town where we now live. As the "ends of the earth" this place where we live has been fought over for centuries. The famous Battle of Guadalete (711) marked the Islamic Invasion of this part of Spain and brought an end to the Christian Church as it was known in Spain until that point. Today our battle is spiritual as we see the horrifying oppresion of false religion played out on both sides of the Strait of Gibraltar. In both Spain and Morocco, the lost masses are culturally assimilated to their country's traditional religion. So we ask you to pray for revival and a spiritual awakening for both sides of the Strait of Gibraltar.
