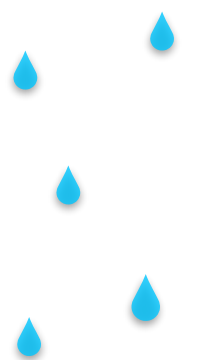
Mission Progress
