who have to go on tours of duty away from their family. It's my duty as "a good soldier of Jesus Christ". It's hard to



and supporters along the way all over TX. I wish I could put photos






Santa Fe ministry: In these past months, I've preached at my church in Santa Fe four times before going to TX: on Nov. 22nd, Dec. 24th & 27th, and Jan. 3rd. Now I'm preaching twice a month: Feb. 7th & 14th, Mar. 13th & 20th, & Apr. 17th, and will finish on Sunday Apr. 24th. On Feb. 3rd I began teaching a 12-week Bible doctrine class to 30-35 people, called "Vital Christianity" which ends Apr. 20th.

My volunteer-teaching is winding down at the Al-Ándalus Seminary by Seville. It starts this month (with an online meeting) as I do a 4-month class as the thesis advisor for one student. Then, when I return to Spain, my final class this school year will be from May 17-July 6th, to teach a "Research and Writing" methods class.

<u>Family news</u>: Salud, Jonathan and Elisabeth are doing fine. Salud has had good checkups on all her appointments. *Thank you for praying for her hernia surgery in Jan.* Many of you know that it went very well and she has had a good recovery these past 8 weeks.
