Last May we finally moved to the area of our next mission project. As we referred to in our previous prayer letter, on May 1st we made a second offer for a house we esteemed very appropriate for our family and ministry, and it was accepted.

On May 11th we signed a rental contract. The mistake of our bank, which caused us to make an extra trip and a good deal regarding the rental of a 18 m³ van precipitated the move within a period of five days.

We praise the Lord for the help of some brethren from Logroño, who helped us to load the first and heaviest load. The "weight of wisdom" (our library) became almost excessive for the van, but we drove calmly and made it all right. Our son Pablo was very helpful loading and downloading. I really had forgotten how a move was; this time, apparently, we had a bit more stuff than when we moved from Pamplona to Logroño. For days we were amidst boxes; however, day by day, order came to the surface. We have not finished yet, but we are at the point of being able to study and minister. We have also

moved our phone, electricity, bank... accounts and have registered as inhabitants of Canyelles.

The biggest project was to divide the terrace located on the second floor, which was to become our study... our "upper room." We built it

with treated wood and glass, and an aluminum door. It has resulted great and accessible. We also praise the Lord for his sustenance; even though our bodies are still sore for the effort, our back has made it well through the carrying of boxes and furniture.

In Logroño...

Our daughter Ana found a very convenient, small apartment and became independent. She will be shortly finishing her studies of Product Design and perhaps enrolling in a Master's program. Pablo just finished his school year (June 6th), and we made an extra trip to get him and get some things that were left in Logroño. He will finish his studies in Tarragona next year. We have still a last visit to make to Logroño: to pick up our last things, to either sell or rent our apartment, and to have a meal the Logroño church finally saying good-bye.

We have also walked the streets of Vilafranca (without tracts in our hands yet), and have been in the church with whom we will be collaborating in Cubelles. As you see, we have just landed in our new area; however, we are joyful in the Lord for everything we have experienced and are expectant for what his will is about to bring our way as we serve him.
