Greetings from the Melendez family down in southern Texas.

I can't believe how much of 2017 has flown by already. I know many of you are probably starting to enjoy cool fall weather, and prepare for the even cooler winter months. We are still in the triple digits waiting for the cool weather to come! It is amazing how easy it is to adapt to our surroundings. I never thought the day would could where 40 degrees would feel so frigid. We arrived in McAllen Texas in August of 2013 for Daniel to



attend Rio Grande Bible Institute. Now, 4 years later, Daniel is taking his final classes and preparing for graduation in December. We also have been serving the Lord in the church "Iglesia Biblica Cristiana Maranatha".

MINISTRY

As of January, we have been leading the youth ministry. Our young group consists of kids aged 12 through 16. We have 2 classes on Sunday mornings where we have been going through topics that are relevant to the young generation. The youth are eager to learn, and often ask questions about how the Bible relates to their world. Recently we have been discussing issues like where God



stands on abortion, sexual purity, how to make wise decisions, and how to study and understand the Bible.

We believe that these kids need a firm foundation in God's word that they will be able to take into adulthood. Our prayer is that they would strive to know, understand, and put the principles found in the Bible into practice in their own lives. We also have a youth small group in our homes on Tuesdays. A lot of the same teens that attend Sunday meetings also attend on Tuesdays. We have been studying the lives of Moses and Joshua, and how the difficulties that we face are very similar. God's promises are the same yesterday, today and tomorrow.

In June, we prepared a 3-day camp for our teens. With the help of our young adults, we prepared a program with Bible classes, worship, devotionals, and games. We rented a secluded retreat site, and had a wonderful time. Every month we go out as a group to do ministry with our young people. Last month we reached out to the homeless and needy people in our community by taking food and other necessary items to people who were out on the street.





Another focal point of the ministry we are involved in is open air Bible studies. We have been leading a small group Bible study in the Milpas public park for several months now. We periodically do evangelistic outreach in the neighborhood surrounding the park. By God's grace many people have begun to regularly attend. Our prayer is to raise leaders in our small group, so that we can plant another one in another location.


