Initially, I went to the city hall to drop off an announcement about the activity to be read on the speaker system of the town (our communication system here), and that simple transaction turned into a conversation with the mayor's secretary who said that she hopes her son will want to go, which in turn led to meeting with the mayor who said that the city hall would advertise it as well and accept sign-ups and would even let us use the soccer stadium of the town should the need arise!! I went to pay to announce an activity and I left with the reminder that God can do so much more than we can ask or think!

This year at camp we have 100+ campers coming during the two weeks. Along with this we have a new dynamic of having two different teams coming to serve these campers. This step to having two teams come may help make the possibility of adding a third week of camp in the future a reality.
