A Church Planting Conference

We were invited to participate in a Church Planting Conference in Internarional Faculty of Theology, where we teach. We shared our participation in a mission church we participated in our youth, and then the projects we carried in Pamplona and Logroño. Two points we made in our analysis have prayerfully stayed in our hearts. One is that in our experience, conversions took place mainly in the first years, and as discipleship and leadership development took on, conversions tended to decrease. We pray that the Lord will maintain our eagerness and occasions to witness as the church grows. And the second thing that I had not realized is that through the years, there have been "casualties" or problems with sin among believers that clearly manifested the work of Satan, making serious harm to some. How we need to pray that the Lord will keep every sheep

Other areas of ministry and life

We continue with eight home bible studies. This Sunday 20th we have an encounter with all who teach or preach either in these groups, Sunday School, Friday Bible Study, or on Sundays. We need to make

sure that the verbal and plenary inspiration of Scripture is clear and evident, something which is becoming a battle in Spain and Europe. We also desire to give some guidelines to be more effective in our Bible teaching.

- The two year program "Prepared to Serve" also continues with blessing. Of the 12 individuals, a couple of them have encountered some personal issues and threaten to leave the course. We pray that the Lord will work and bring them to a maturity that will make them useful servants.
- On March 7 we had a small motorcycle accident, due to a car that did not respect my right of way. No broken bones, praise the Lord, but a painful foot and rib for a couple of months, and about a month and a half of rehabilitation. During that time of recuperation the schedule became a bit tight, and I went around a bit slow. But, praise the Lord, we have almost totally recovered. Only a bit of pain comes up at times.
- May 6th in Spain was Mother's day. We took the opportunity and as a part of the service, Rosa and another lady gave a testimony of how had they experienced Christian motherhood, particularly in relation to sharing our faith with our children, and the heart that the Lord desires as we do that. A month earlier we dealt with parenthood. It is our custom to have a special evangelistic service every first Sunday of the month. On both occasions, we had a number of people visiting. We praise the Lord for these good times.
