**3 Months already gone...**

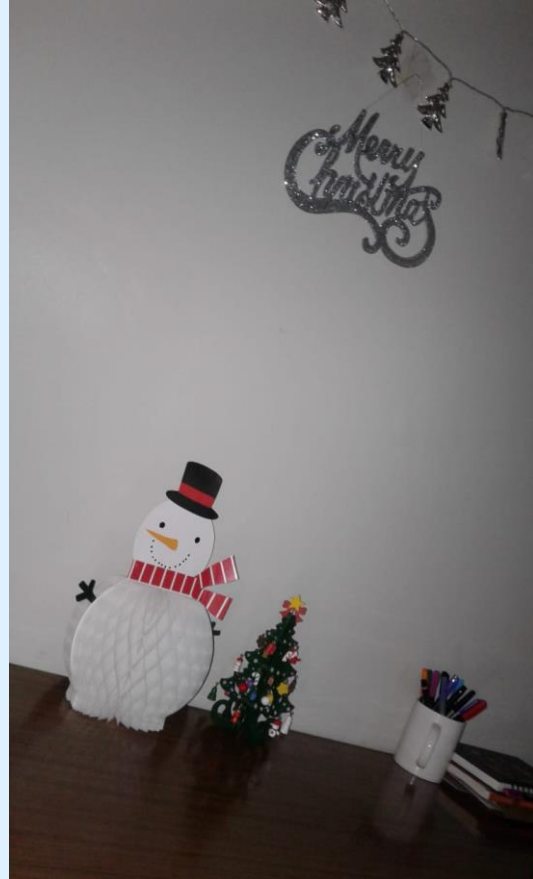


I was able to get my visitor's visa extended for another 3 months. Praise the Lord!

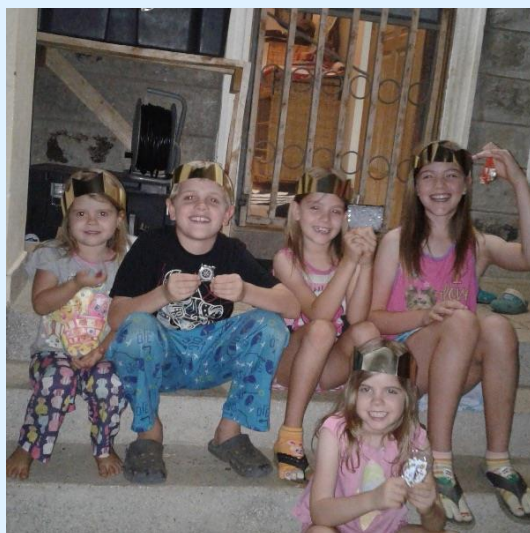
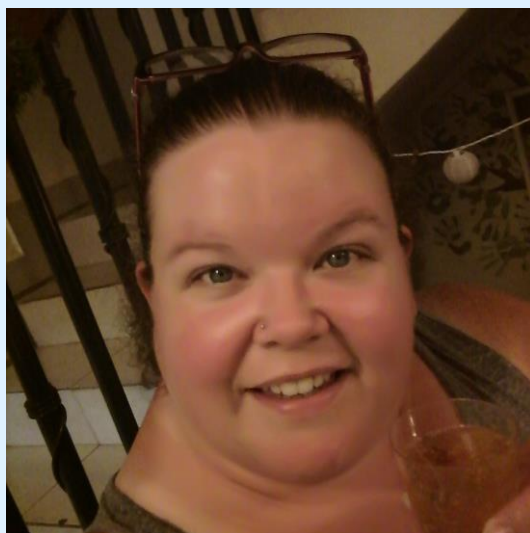


Please pray for my work permit. We are getting all the papers I need together so that Daniel (the guy helping me apply) can get it all sent in. Pray that it will go through as

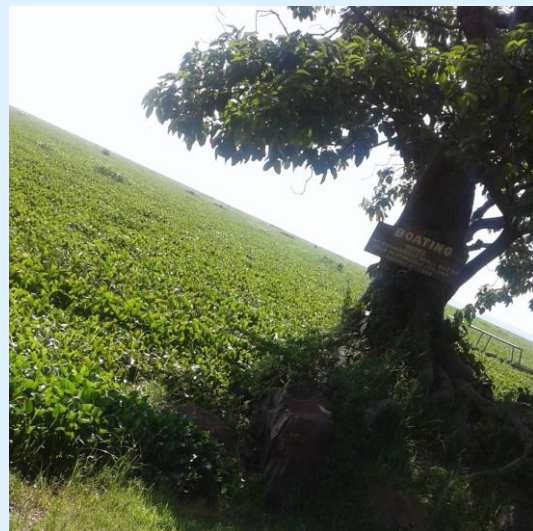
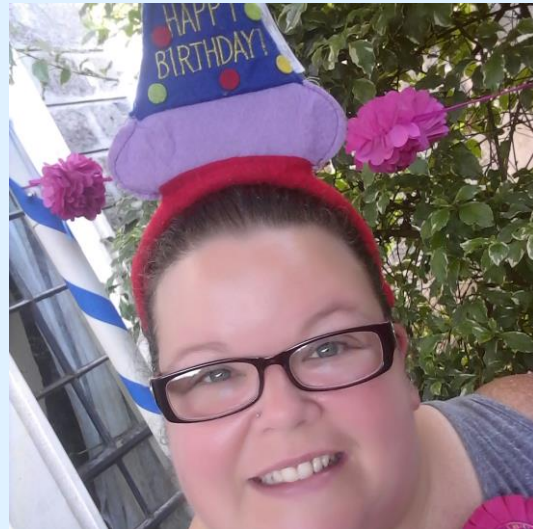
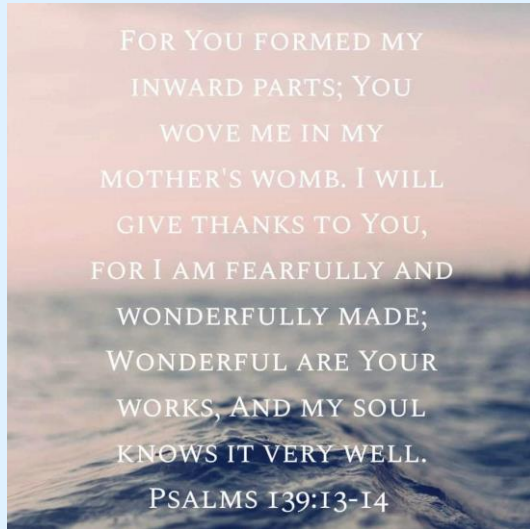
