gatherings anytime. We will be on a major street here in Las Vegas. Something else that is exciting is that it has a lot of parking and good exposure to the community.

This facility has 3 classrooms and a restroom that is not pictured. It also has a little lobby that has the bar area that you see, and then a large room that is not fully pictured. In the large room, we believe that we could comfortably seat 50 people and possibly up to 75 people when needed.

I'm so thankful for my family. Here are some of the pictures of the events above.



























Hopefully, you have seen that we have a lot to praise God for.
