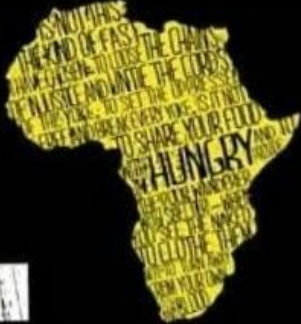
With a heavy heart...but full of peace!!!
