- we know we will be so blessed and encouraged by others we pray that we would ALSO be a blessing and encouragement to others whom we encounter in their lives-like a light and a living testimony to the love of Christ that is in us.
- that we will be unified and connected as a family, as a couple...and most importantly, as individuals with our Lord. Please pray that we will look to HIM for our fulfillment, joy, peace, strength, patience, comfort, and contentment ALL the time-but especially as we are heading into a new season of change and unfamiliarity in lifestyle, location, schedule, pace, etc.
- For the pastors as we are gone; that they will continue to learn and "grow in the grace and the knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ."
- For the "rabbit project" especially while we are gone; it is still a very young, and underdeveloped project at this point.
- for our home, car, and other worldly possessions to be protected and preserved while we are away.

The Lord is already, as always, showing Himself (or showing off)! He has begun to provide for our family "abundantly above and beyond what we could even ask or imagine!" It has been a tremendous encouragement to be reminded that the Lord knows us, and our needs, even better and before we even can see or understand them. And He is faithful to provide for ALL of our needs, according to His riches in glory, IN CHRIST JESUS. We are confident that no matter what we will face-He is faithful. He will be with us, and He will provide HIMSELF as the fulfillment of our very greatest need.
