Puebla del Río Church ministry. Salud and six Puebla church ladies just got back from a retreat (May 31-June 2nd) for women from Seville-area churches at the Christian camp north of Seville. They came back encouraged by what the speaker taught. About 50 women from 5-6 different Evangelical churches in the Seville area went. The Saturday the ladies were gone, Jordi gave a men's study and fellowship time to the men from church on what the Bible says to Christian

men about their responsibilities and we went out for supper. Now the men want to repeat

the study and fellowship time – and even have a men's retreat at camp sometime this year! Also, the church's bi-weekly cell group met at our house in May, with 15 people

in our living room! Jordi has been with the church for 2 years now and has 2 years left to complete the 4-yr. transition time we proposed when we brought him on. It

is going well, and we're all encouraged by how the Lord has used him in the church. His wife, Sandra, helps with the praise music too. *Please pray for Jordi and Sandra and their ministry in the Puebla church.*

<u>Other ministries</u>. For the past 8 years, **Salud** has volunteered once a month to team-teach a weekly Bible study for a ministry that works with retired &

elderly people (anywhere from 8 to 15 adults). She has just finished the last study at the end of May. On June 11th, I finish teaching a 6-week class at the Seminary on the doctrine of Salvation (Soteriology) and will be done until the fall classes. On June 1st, I helped start a 2nd cycle of the expository preaching circle with 8 men from 6 churches in an overview of *Jonah*. The plan is to meet from Sept. to Jan. and do one chap. each time then 3 volunteers will preach and be evaluated by the rest. I've also helped the past 12 months with a Bible project by writing the introduction summaries to all the NT books, the 6 poetical OT books, and this summer need to try to finish the 33 other OT book introductions.



Family news: On May 24th, we moved **Jonathan** to his apartment in Jaén, about 180 miles east of here. He started at the hospital on May 27th as the Resident Intern Oncologist. It is the residency that he hoped and prayed to get, and the Lord worked it out! Now he and **Irene** are just a few miles away from each other (and can go out several times a week instead of once a month like it has been for them these past 2 years). We're very happy for them and how God is working in them. We look forward to their wedding

in just 5 months! Please pray for Jonathan as he adapts to working and attending patients at the hospital, and for he and Irene as they prepare for their wedding on Nov. 2^{nd} .

Elisabeth has finished her 3rd yr. at the Univ. of Granada. She'll be home for the summer, and work in July at the English day-camp near Seville where she has worked the past 3 summers. In Aug. she, Jonathan and Irene will be dorm counselors for one week at a Bible camp for teens. We're proud of how she helps in so many ways. *Pray for God to help her continue growing into the best teacher she can be.*

We again thank all of you who pray for us and/or support us to serve God here in southern Spain. Without you we couldn't be full-time in the ministry. May God bless you for that, and also bless you with "making the most of your time" with Jesus Christ all of this summer!
