

August Prayer Letter

Dear Friends,

Last year around this time, we had all our belongings packed and traveled to the States and started sharing our burden for Spain. I am grateful for all that God has taught us this year and for the ways He has directed us. And of course, for the opportunities He gave us to invite you to join us in reaching Spain.

Let me share with you two great things that have happened this month. Both answers to prayer:

I have a job! I had applied to just about everything possible. God has opened a flexible, part-time job at an English Academy here in Fraga. I will work 20 hours a week some in the mornings and some in the afternoons. This academy is very involved in the community. They do many activities during the year with the students and it should be a great way to connect. I start the middle of September.

As I was planning this prayer update, I got a call from a Christian lady in Fraga. She was part of a small group of believers led by a missionary that had to return home a few years ago. We knew about this group through a church in a nearby city. I can't express the joy that this phone call brought to both of us.

She was so happy to hear our desire to establish a church and that out of all the places in Spain, we would come to Fraga! We will meet with her soon. I can't wait to tell you about this.

August has been quiet in Fraga, with fewer opportunities for interaction. During this time, I've been able to get some teaching English certifications. We have also prepared materials to print and produce for evangelism and first contact (I have sent them to leaders here for feedback before printing.) I'll share them with you soon! We had bracelets made for sharing the gospel. I saw the English version from Dare2Share, and I got their permission to reproduce it in Spanish.

I am also creating a website and social media presence for our church plant. The City Hall and non-profits use Facebook as their main form of communicating with people in Fraga. We also want to give people an opportunity to find us online, and we believe that these tools may give the community more exposure to the gospel.

I have been looking forward to September for the town to come alive again. Please pray for us as activities start up.

- For me as I begin work, that I would be a light in a dark place
- For our interactions with organizations, neighbors, and others
- For us to continue to get accustomed to this town's particular culture and discover the best ways to reach the people here.

As you pray for us, you remain continually on our minds and in our prayers. We hope that this letter finds you also encouraged to engage those around you with the gospel. We greatly enjoy working alongside you for the cause of Christ.
