We found out that because this is my first time applying, Kenya's immigration wants to do a site visit of the Tentmakers Bible Mission Kenya's office. They will be checking to see if we are a real society, what we are doing, and what I will be doing when I return. Most importantly, they will determine if a Kenyan can do what I will be doing. If my work can be done by a Kenyan, there is no need for me to be there. That's how they see it. As far as I know there isn't any Kenyans doing what I will be doing, so there shouldn't be a problem.

We were first told that our office had to be on a commercial property but were later informed that was not the case. So, we have prepared the office we have now and have invited immigration to come and see it.

I'm told this is going to be the long wait. I can't imagine, as I feel as though the wait has already been long. But like most things in Kenya and even more so when it comes to government processes, things move very slowly and it will happen in the timing of the person that will be coming to visit. We can pray the Lord will move them to come quickly and this part of the wait will be over.

### Keeping focused......

As the Lord works diligently on my work permit, I will continue to serve Him where I am. He has given me so many opportunities to share about what He is doing and I'm so grateful. There is no lack of need on this side of the pond and I'm honored to be working with the Lord in the things He brings my way.

As well as taking opportunities to serve, taking the time to grow closer to the Lord and cultivating my relationship with Him is so very important. There is nothing I can do apart from Him and I want to know and understand my identity in Him and always put Him first. Keeping my focus on HIM...where it needs to be, will continue to help me in this waiting period.
