After more than four years following the path that God wanted us to take, He has led us, in His perfect timing, to a landing place. In May our Mission Board, Tentmakers Bible Mission asked us to consider taking a position in the home office in La Grange, Wyoming. The position would be writing and developing resources to help our missionaries train national pastors in doctrine within their own culture. We spent some time in prayer about this offer, and then took a trip out to Wyoming to meet with the rest of the office staff, some of the Mission Board, and Chuck Mathias, who is the Director of this program at Tentmakers. Through the discussions and prayer we had there, we knew that God wanted us to take this step. The Board voted yes on our acceptance, and now the adventure begins!

- What will we be doing? As Assistant Director of International Bible Training, Nathaniel will be researching and helping to develop resources that will aid missionaries in training national pastors. These pastors know the salvation message but they need more training to be effective church planters in their own countries. Our American curricula can be confusing and hard to implement in another culture, which learns and understands differently than we do in the U.S. Nathaniel's job will be to build a curriculum that is customized to the culture and then he will begin implementing that curriculum into these other cultures along with the missionary who is serving there. This will involve lots of communication with the missionaries and the implementation phase will require trips overseas to work with the missionary in their own country.
- When will this move be happening? We have been challenged to be in La Grange by May of 2020. This seems like a daunting task but we have a great God who can do mighty things! These next months will definitely not be idle. In addition to all the other moving preparations, we must raise the necessary support before we leave. This is going to involve a lot of visiting churches and individuals and planning our move across the country...again. ^(C) We will also be emotionally preparing our family for this huge change in our life. The children are already super excited, but also feeling the loss of friends and family here in Michigan. Pray for all of these emotions we will all be facing in the coming months!
- What can you do to help? We need help! This is not a job that we can do alone. We are facing a huge task! As an extension/part of the body of Christ, we need the support of the whole body. God has a role for all of us, is yours as part of this team?

- Support Raising We know beyond any doubt that this is where God wants us. What we do not know is how He is going to get us there. Pray that God will send people to us to join this ministry and help us financially.
