September Prayer Letter

Dear Family and Friends,

I hope you've had a great month. We sure did! I started teaching English classes a couple weeks ago. I also started volunteering with the Red Cross this past Friday bringing people to adult care centers around town. I have been participating in a local association promoting the revitalization of the old town and preservation of historical places. This past weekend, they invited famous artists to paint walls within the old town. Visitors explored seldom-used streets. I assisted with giving tours on electric scooters through the medieval layout of the town and Donovan was able to join me. It was quite the experience!

Thanks to your support of the North Spain Project, I have been able to be involved in these activities. Some have asked me if I "want to be involved in everything around town." And others commented that "not too many people give up their free time to help around here." This has given me the opportunity to have longer conversations because we are showing interest in the people and the community. We continue to pray that God would allow for more conversations and relationships toward more gospel conversations and regular Bible studies.

"Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven." Matt 5:16

One example of these conversations was this past Friday. While talking with another volunteer, she asked me about my story. I shared that we are missionaries, and that we are burdened to start a church here in Fraga. This led to lots of questions that she had about religion. I shared my testimony and I was able to relate to her objections (which were similar to ones I had as a teenager). The next day, I spoke with another volunteer and the conversation went similarly. Both mentioned that the people in Fraga are "very tied to our own ideas." Aren't we all though? I was also very much tied to my own perspective of the world, of God, and of what my life should be... until God became very real to me.

Prayer Points

- For more opportunities to share—our desire to start a church, the gospel, or our testimony. We pray that God will use these to draw people to Himself.
- For my preaching at the church in Vilanova this coming Sunday
 Oct. 6th. My focus is to encourage the young people to strengthen their relationship with God while they are young.
- For God to move in the hearts of people that we have met, that they would continue to have questions and a desire to interact with us.
