At the beginning of October, I preached in Villanova, Cataluyna. The service went well and several mentioned how the message has opened up an opportunity to share their commitment to the Lord. Praise God! Thank you for praying for this.

During the week of our town's holiday (*fiestas*), I worked with an event planner that partners with the town hall and local artists. We believe this connection may be beneficial when it's our time to host a large-scale event for all of Fraga to hear the gospel.

We have been considering hosting an evangelistic campaign in Fraga next summer through *Decision* Spain. We have prayed about it and we recognize wisdom in first using a year to establish relationships before attempting to host such an event. I have had more opportunities to share with people about our mission in Fraga. While reactions remain largely dubious, some have shown cautious curiosity. I have the impression that they would like to know more, but prefer to wait until they know of someone else that has attended a Bible study.

To begin hosting Bible studies, we have decided to rent a small office that has access to a small conference room. Having this space will provide a comfortable and professional environment for guests.

- One weekend, we visited my parents and appreciated our time spent with them. My mom continues to digress quickly and we ask for your tender prayers for her comfort.
- Please pray for my meeting next week with the town mayor in which I will present a town-wide volunteering idea.
- For Spain's elections on the 10th, I have been summoned to serve at the voting hall. Pray that this will be an opportunity to become more familiar with people in town. We are starting to not be strangers!
- At the end of November, seminary students from Barcelona will come and help us with our outreach. We plan to use their help to host an engaging seminar that leads to participants in bible studies.

Thank you so much for your prayers and support. It's exciting to see God answering prayers and opening doors for a ministry to be established here in Fraga.
