We pray for your health and encouragement, and for opportunities to share the reason for the hope we have. We love you and we are very thankful for your support of our ministry that helps us through. We have seen God provide in wonderful ways. I still am able to teach many of my English classes now online at home. God has protected us from severe illness and we are all well. The greatest blessing of this time we hold in our

arms every day: Wesley Luca Ramirez, born on March 14. God's timing was perfect and Maddy's mom was here to help us. This was a huge blessing as it was a stressful time with everything shutting down and much to take care of. God also worked out that she could return to the States just before the borders were closed. We rest in God's sustaining grace.

I have continued to minister online through the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association. People come to pages such as SearchforJesus.net and interact with volunteers to get biblical answers for their spiritual questions. I have had some good conversations sharing hope with people during this time. I am also continuing to prepare for the seminary class I am teaching next fall.

We are trying to find creative ways of interaction, and especially thinking toward future ministry. Oddly enough, because of the quarantine, we have seen our neighbors more. We look forward to more opportunities to share Christ's hope with them. The measures in Spain have been strict and we are confined at home. This week we have been allowed to take the kids out for a walk, and activity will slowly increase. There is widespread uncertainty of what things are going to look like for everybody. Although most activities have been cancelled or postponed, we are softly planning our summer, but can't expect things to move quickly as we would like.
