We want to give you a brief update of how things are unfolding on our end:

The president (of Kenya) addressed the nation today to announce how things have progressed over the 21 day trial period set in place, in order to determine the way forward for the people of Kenya. If we are understanding everything correctly, it looks like the borders will remain open...and we will in fact be able to fly out of Kenya on August 3rd \(\mathbb{X} \) This only leaves 6 remaining days before we will fly! Please pray for our family and ALL that this entails in the next week \(\mathbb{L} \) Specific prayer requests:

*That we will be able to have the tests for Covid 19 done at a qualified place for a reasonable rate, and a workable time/date

*That we will all test negative for the Covid test

*For our various transportation and timing plans to pan out as hoped and prayed for.

*For travel mercies: by bus, by plane, and by car.

*For health, safety and protection throughout all of our travels, for our whole family: from and for everything, but especially against Corona virus. (We know the Lord is sovereign and in control: and we are trying to "cast all our cares upon Him-knowing that He cares for us."

*For our hearts as we say our last "good-byes" to special people, places, and memories and process it all.

*That we would honor the Lord and others as we aim to appreciate the blessing others are and have been in our lives here in Kenya. That we would be able to "end" (or) "leave well."

*And of course for peace, patience, love, and an extra BIG measure of grace for one another, and ourselves through it all: packing, prepping, planning, leaving, and letting go.
