He identified her issues with panic and taught us the tools to overcome it. Then, in December, we got the approval from him and our agency to return to the field. We wanted to return right away to get back to ministry and to begin

research for a future business, but we decided to buy tickets for the spring because of the extreme debilitating cold there. But of course COVID prevented us from getting back at that time. But even if we had flown back, we would've been in quarantine there (which I think has been much harder for them compared to us). Also, trying to leave there during this time is a lot more complicated because of the virus.

Overall, in retrospect, things are going according to plan, it's just not the plan I had in mind, and we **very** much look forward to when God plans to get us back. But in the meantime, we need to be saving money for the cost of starting a business there, so I am now looking for a job I can work until it's time to leave.
