<u>CHURCH</u> – After six months without meetings we will be back on the first Sunday of October at our church building for our gatherings to worship together. We are excited and looking forward to this time where we will be seeing each other personally instead of virtual meetings through a screen. During the time we did not have our meetings at church, we have reached out to the most vulnerable families in the slum near our church helping them with some basic

needs.

In our last letter we mentioned how Chucky, the drug lord in the slum, sent word that he wanted to talk with us. He expressed his gratitude for what we were doing to help the families in his community. The Lord is working in this man's heart and he already took his first big step and renounced his position as drug lord. Chucky said he does not understand what is happening to him because he no longer feels the desire to seek vengeance towards those he considered as his enemies. He still is required by the authorities to wear an electronic tag on his ankle and he is only allowed to be near his home. Even with his limitations he shows a great desire to help us by encouraging the youth to come to soccer training and Bible study in the slum. Please pray for Junior (Chucky) to completely surrender his life to Jesus, so he can be greatly used as an instrument for God's glory.



We thank God for all He has done and all that is being accomplished in many lives by the power of the Gospel. We praise God for His sustaining love and mercies that are new every morning. Thank you for your prayers as we move forward with the calling God has for us in taking this mighty message of hope, which many are waiting to hear.
