

# *November Prayer Letter*

Dear Family and Friends,

We have important updates about our ministry in Fraga to share with you! We have had a few opportunities to feel normal again in the midst of the restrictions that are continually being modified to control the pandemic in specific locations. We are thankful to God for His protection towards our family and we hope that you have also felt Him present in your life.

My employment in this season has experienced some changes. I have started working again with the Red Cross, but this year as a part-time worker instead of volunteer. Although as a part of this organization I can't be very forward talking about God or sharing the gospel with people, I do have many opportunities to minister to the families and the people that I get in contact with through my job, both while on the clock and when we meet on the street. I have had a few interesting conversations with my coworkers already and one of them is very interested and open to talk about God with me. I shared the gospel with him very clearly the second day we were together and he has asked questions about my faith since then. These conversations have been very encouraging, and I would appreciate your prayers for him.

I am still teaching English; this year I am doing it as an independent tutor and I have more freedom to talk with my students and parents about issues and bring a Christian perspective to the table. A few of my adult students have already shown interest in Christianity.

We have started a Bible study online! So far, we have met three consecutive weeks and the feedback has been very positive. The participants are Christians who have been hurt by church leaders in the past yet maintain a relationship with God. I feel both a privilege and a challenge to help them get back on mission, discipling them through Discovery Bible Studies and encouraging them to share what they have learned. One of them has already shared what we learned last week with a coworker and had a very nice conversation.

- For those who are curious about God and have questions to continue asking and to find the answers in the Bible.
- For more opportunities to share the Hope we have in God

We are excited about these changes, the new contacts, the new conversations, and the beginning of a Bible study. We look forward to more ministry opportunities and gospel conversations. We are so thankful to God for opening doors and for helping us through them. Also, we are thankful to Him for your partnership with us in ministry. Your prayers and your financial support are helping us develop our ministry here. We appreciate very much your investment in this ministry.
