Greetings from Spain! Things here have been busy! I sent out the message that Ashton had his launch for the first meeting of the ministry he and two friends he met through a college student app, created and it went really well! They had the first meeting and then had a guest speaker at the next – apologist Tim Barnett. There was even one young lady that attended both meetings that lives in Hong Kong and is the only believer in her family. She was so excited to find other like-minded youth! Please continue to pray for this outlet and that it will reach those wanting to grow their faith.

In Tafalla, we are planning to have our first live service this year on Sunday! You may remember I wrote back in November that we had a sewage pipe leak in the building that opened up in our ceiling. It was a mess! Insurance came out, we have cleaned up, painted and had the floors refinished. God went above and beyond in that the insurance payout for having the hardwood floors refinished was enough to cover the floor, the paint, and a new rug for the platform! We had a local man do the floor and Sharon and I painted the ceiling and walls. The church has a fresh new look and we are excited for Sunday! With the Covid precautions in place, we are only allowed 15 participants based on our square footage so we asked the group who would be able to come and we have 15 signed up! We have been and will continue to also put the sermon videos online.

This year we have challenged the group to memorize scripture. Sharon's uncle is a pastor in central Texas and he challenged the church he pastors to memorize 52 verses – one each week for each week of the year. An idea he had from reading the book by O. S. Hawkins: "52 Verses Every Christian Should Know". Each week he is preaching a sermon on it. Sharon was very excited about this new series and was telling me about it and I decided we should do a similar idea here! On Monday mornings, I put up an 8-10 minute video with the verse and its importance. We made cards, printed and laminated them and bound them with a binder ring so that those participating will have the verses all together and can use it to practice memorizing. As we go along, we will print the next grouping and laminate and give it out.

Going forward, I would like to pursue and present apologetic ideas. With that in mind, we are in need of those materials in Spanish. I would like to get a collection of books to display in the window where people walk by and also have another copy that could be checked out for those wanting to read it.
