The teenage youth group has been a great blessing as well. We started it in July because we had four teens coming to church. We now have had sixteen or more come and at least twelve every Saturday. They have all brought friends and some have been coming to church and Bible study as well. This is such a great thing we see going on right before our eyes and it is so encouraging seeing the teens bring people into the church services.



We also started a food distribution once a month for the under privileged in the neighborhood. It is called Tonelado de Amor which is Tons of Love in English, we ask the church people to bring food items and then a group went out to give it away after the women divide it all into bags. They were able to pray for each family they went to and it was a blessing to everyone.



Josh has been preaching through Galatians on Sunday mornings and then I get to translate it into Spanish. It is really great! I am teaching through Romans on Wednesday evening Bible study and prayer meeting.
