March 17, 2022 Dear Family and Friends,

We've just made a small and temporary change in the ministry. For the next 3 months we will be helping a different church here in Arequipa that is much closer to our house. Our goal is to help them with the teaching and instruction in doctrine with the hope that the church will bring glory to God via believers that are able to put the Bible into practice in their lives. Tonight, Thursday, is the first prayer meeting that this church has had since March, 2020. We will also be starting up the Sunday evening service



and Ángela will possibly be helping get the Sunday school for the little kids started up again. There are other things that need done and we will help where we can. However, we made it very clear that we are not planning to do everything. Florentino and Oscar are the elders and I recently started a weekly Monday evening meeting with just them in order to discuss the work, pray for the brothers, and study a little from the Bible. Please pray that our time with the church at Ciudad Blanca will bare eternal fruit in the believers.

The Uchumayo ministry continues every Saturday. Recently, through donations from 3 families, we were able to purchase 23 pairs of shoes to give to the kids that attend the Bible study. The majority is school age and so we bought black shoes to use as part of the school uniform. All-in-all I think they were all happy to have received the shoes. And we thank God and those that donated for this project.

The February month of renewing documents and ID's has extended into March. The only thing left is my new Peruvian residency card which is scheduled to be ready for pickup the 29th of March. Ángela's immigration process is moving along. It's slow, but we can still see a little progress. We got her 3 police background checks back and the good news is



that she's not a criminal and so now the National Visa Center is reviewing all the documents that we've submitted and we hope to hear something in the next couple of months as to the next part of the process.

My laser printer decided that it needed

a rest and so I sent it to the repair guy to see what happened. Hopefully he finds something that is cheap to fix.

Well, I think that's about it for now. Thank you for your prayers and support.
