Dear Friends,

On Feb. 27th, just 3 days after returning from our trip to Texas, Frank preached on Ps. 121 in our home church. It says: *"I will lift up my eyes to the*

mountains; from where will my help come? My help comes from the LORD, who made heaven and earth... The LORD will guard your going out and your coming in, from this time forth and forever." (vv. 1, 8) Since Nov. 5th our view each day has been *"the mountains"* in Santa Fe, NM. But our *"help has come from the LORD"* who has guarded our *"going out and...coming in"* for the past 4 months, and He'll continue to do so as we watch world events.



Home Assignment ministry. Our total 6 months in the U.S. is near to ending. In 8 weeks, **on May 4th Lord willing, we'll fly back to Seville** to start a new term of full-time missionary service. We've seen many of you who pray for us

and support us. We saw believers in 7 churches be very encouraged by our ministry and become more aware of the great spiritual need in Spain & the need for ministry help there. One person who saw our presentation of the work in Spain told Salud, "It looks like that's a full-time job." We didn't know that anyone would think it was not a full-time job! Salud has seen friends whom she hadn't seen since 2009. She also gave 3 conferences in English for a Ladies Retreat at a church that supports us. Our Texas trip covered 2,900 miles in 25 days.



Only 5 days before that we did a 1,200 mile 4-day trip to Colorado. Yet God kept us safe and out of the big snowstorms as we traveled. In Texas, we spoke at Río Grande Bible Institute and encouraged many students there, and we did a Marriage seminar at a Spanish-speaking church. He also kept us safe from Covid when most of

Frank's family had it and we had to quarantine twice. But we've tested negative each time! We still have one trip up to the TBM Home Office in Wyoming, and a possible



trip to a seminary in California later in March and April. **Thank you for praying for us as we travel and share about our work in Spain, and also please pray for our return to Spain on May 4th.** We don't know what will happen in Europe because of the Russian war against Ukraine, but we trust that God will take us back to keep serving in Spain.



Other ministry. After returning to Seville, Frank will teach 2 sessions of a *Contemporary Ministry Issues* class on May 23rd and 30th, while another

professor will do the rest of the class. In the fall semester he'll teach a full history class for the Master's degree in the Spanish Reformation. Due to a shortage of funds for many things at the Seminary, the TBM Board of Directors has approved our request to raise donations to help the Seminary buy new books, materials, shelf space, etc.; **especially for the Library special collection section for studies in the Spanish Reformation.** If you'd like to help with this, you can send your tax-deductible donations to TBM, designated: **Seville Seminary Library Fund.** Donations can be sent as of now, but the fund will be open only one year (until March 2023). **All donations will go 100% to the Seminary Library,** TBM withholds nothing.
