This is just a quick update on Angela's immigration status/process. We solicited an expedited appointment for her Peruvian passport, which is crucial to finishing the visa process. After more than 3 weeks of hearing nothing back and several phone calls with various friends and acquaintances that either work or have worked in immigrations and with some others that were able to get a passport. Friday the 23<sup>th</sup>, I was able to finally make an appt. The catch is that we had to drive to Puno that very day. It's a 4.5 hour drive and we arrived an hour and a half early and decided to see if she could get in right away. AND SHE COULD! It was maybe 30 min. and she was done. They told her to come back at 4 pm to pick it up. So having a little time to spare, we walked





around a bit and then grabbed a cup of coffee. At 4 pm on the dot, which is very rare down here, the lady arrived with Angela's passport and we breathed a large sigh of relief and thanked God for working this all out.

Oct. 15<sup>th</sup> we fly to Lima and the 17<sup>th</sup> she has an immigration visa medical exam where they will top off her vaccines among other things. Then on the 26<sup>th</sup> she has the big interview at the embassy. She will have to do that alone, but won't have to speak English yet, which is a big relief to her. If everything advances as planned, and if she gets her visa on the 26<sup>th</sup>, then we will be able to start looking for plane tickets to the US. That means we could be in the States sometime in the first 10 days of December, God willing. We also want to thank you for your prayers and we ask that you please keep praying.
