The drought this summer has made me even more sympathetic to the weariness of a dry land. As someone who grew up around lakes and streams, I have often complained, yearning for water. My

complaints are inexcusable, especially in light of David's words. Does my body yearn for God in the same way? How often have I complained because of thirst for Him? All too often, I take God for granted, and do not search for Him the way I should. Right now, I would gladly drive hours to jump in a lake. Would I do the same to hear from God's word? To meet with Christ's Body? To talk with the Lord? The fact is, most of us have ready access to these things, yet neglect them, not valuing them the same way David describes. I hope this reminder is useful for you as it is for me. We are so grateful for your faithful prayer as you serve as part of our ministry team.
