We praise Him for the privilege to share the gospel during planned evangelism days or when God places new friends into our lives. We praise Him for allowing us to be part of His ministry of bringing the truth of the Gospel into this area. The truth that Christ Jesus existed in the form of God, did not regard His equality with God a thing to cling to, emptied Himself, took the position of a slave, became a man, humbled Himself, and became obedient to death, even a cross kind of death.
