

October 2022 Prayer Letter

Dear Friends,

I owe you a report on the evangelistic outreach we had on the 1st of October. Thank you so much for praying for the event and for us! We live-streamed two conferences that day. The one in the morning against bullying started very late because of some technical difficulties. Some people got tired of waiting and left. We had 6 people at first, but only two stayed to hear Nick.

In the evening, we also had 6 people come and they got to hear Nick's testimony of his search for truth and purpose. He gave a clear presentation of the Gospel. He was approachable, kind, and biblical in his exposition. It was well done. In Madrid, many people responded to his invitation to accept Christ. Praise God! I have done follow-up with the people that came in Fraga. One person shared, "What I got out of it was that you need a lot of self-esteem and inner strength to get over difficult circumstances..." Not quite on point, but we are praying that God continues to work in their hearts.

The focus of our ministry remains to share the gospel with people around us, to plant a church through discipleship, and to see multiplication and growth. As I pursue more avenues to reach our community with the Gospel, I recently came across Pure Desire Ministries. They are a ministry which focuses on providing

hope, freedom and healing from sexual brokenness through Jesus Christ. We see in our community a need for resources for addiction recovery and Christian counseling. I like Pure Desire's approach to healing through creating a culture of grace within the church, focusing on making the church a place where people can come and be open about their struggles and find support and healing. I am looking forward to seeing if speaking on these prevalent and difficult subjects will draw more people to the freedom found in Christ.

Last weekend, I had a chance to share my testimony and God's victory in my life with young people at a church in the nearby city of Lleida. We spent the afternoon together, shared thoughts, tools, and experiences, and I challenged them to be open about their need for help before it is too late. I left them with the main idea that Christ offers us real freedom and real satisfaction within the boundaries of His will. We don't have to focus on the negative things we can't or shouldn't do; rather we have to focus in all the beauty and joy of all the things we get to do because we are free in Christ.
