their ministry needs to transition to another step.

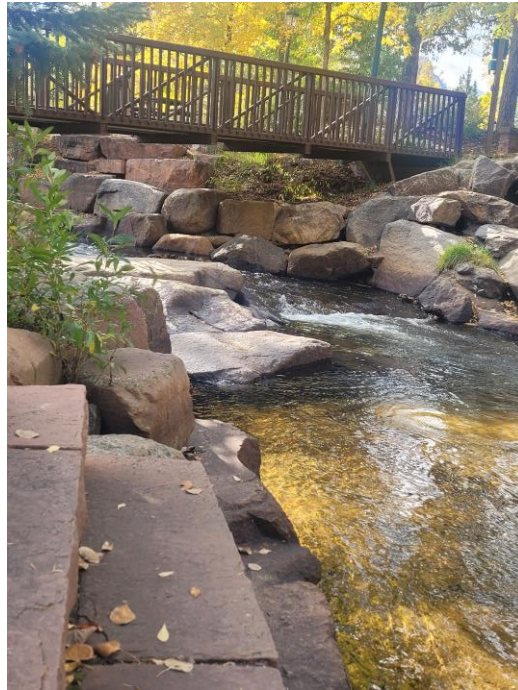
