Speaking of Peru, the country is in a crisis. There are a lot of violent protests including senseless killings by the police, army, and civilians. They have closed the Arequipa airport again and it sounds like some of the equipment at the airport has been damaged. Our plan is to head back in April. Please pray that the situation will deescalate and that we won't have any issues returning to Arequipa.

Also pray for Jasmin, Jose Luis, Milan, Daniel and the others that help us in the Uchumayo ministry on Saturdays. At times the roads are blocked and filled with protestors. Pray that they will be prudent and for God's protection.
