We've been in Peru for 2 weeks and feel as busy as ever. I really wanted to do a video update this time but time hasn't allowed it so this will have to do.

May 5th, Angela begins an intensive English course. She will be in classes 3 hours every morning Mon-Fri and then she will have homework to do when she gets home. This means that she will have to cut quite a few things out of her schedule. Please pray for her in learning English and in saying no to other responsibilities and opportunities for the time being.

May 10th, COFOPRI will be returning to Rosario to continue the titling process. Three of our 6 lots have been approved. Please pray that the other 3 will also be approved quickly. Also pray for others in our Bible study such as Delia, Gustavo and others that also need to be approved.

We had been planning on starting construction of a house in Rosario this year but with Angela's English classes and a future trip to the States to finish up her citizenship, we decided it would be better to wait. Speaking of going to the States, we have communicated with immigration and are planning on her interview sometime in April, 2024. So that means arriving the end of March and probably staying stateside for another 3-4 months again. Lord willing, Angela will be a US citizen

We took her to one of the cisterns where the man in charge of the distribution and maintenance of the water confronted us. He started shouting at us and accused us of slander among other things. It really didn't make any sense and just reaffirmed how corrupt and abusive the situation is, especially for those that live there. Lizzie shared with our group, Saturday afternoon, about why water purity is important and how to filter it while demonstrating a small easy to clean affordable filter. After that I shared from Revelation 22:17 about the water of life that Jesus Christ offers to all that thirst, and He offers it free of charge. Praise be to God for our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, the source of the purist water.
