First of all, it is so great to have the Griggs back in Peru with us again! They gave us an idea of putting on a big evangelistic banquet in the church, which we completed in April. There were many from our church who served in such humbling ways; one guy built an outdoor stage, others helped multiple nights putting together the decorations, others helped with making goody bags for the visitors, and many more helped with the inviting and evangelizing. Our guest speaker, a pastor from Lima, gave a powerful message about the parable where Jesus taught about the great banquet where those who were invited didn't want to come, so the Master sent his servants to invite everyone else, but them! Many people came forward to dedicate themselves to a relationship with Jesus Christ.

Because of that banquet, I have been able to start a little discipleship with my landlady and a young woman who came.



Backtracking, in February we had our VBS. It also was themed about the parable of that same banquet. I got to work with a dear sister, Viviana, and we taught the oldest group, the 9–12-year-olds. We had lots of fun and shared the Gospel with many children.



Since January, I have been teaching English to a young girl named Ximena. I started out with three students, and then it dwindled down to 1. Just today that number became 0. It seems like around the 3-month mark, life just changes for people, and they can't continue with the English classes. Please pray for me in this aspect. I'm not sure that I should keep teaching English. I think that there are other things the Lord is calling me to.

I have a boyfriend! His name is Lenin, and he is from Tarapoto. I think he might be the one, so please pray for this relationship, that we would glorify the Lord in

everything. Pray that if the Lord does not want to use us together, that He will separate us. He gets asked a lot to teach the Bible in our church, and his theology is really solid.



The Griggs have revived a heart for going out and reaching the tribal people with the Gospel. I am interested in seeing what the Lord may have for me in helping them. This may be one of the reasons English doesn't seem to be working out.
