
June 2023 Prayer Letter

"Bureaucracy!" "Your little lettuce."


We thought we were so close on the building a couple weeks ago and get reforms underway, but we encountered Mafalda's pet—bureaucracy. Documents, and papers, and meetings, problems, ideas, and brainstorming solutions... but now we have a closing date—June 27! We then will get the keys to the building and begin renovations, Lord willing on Iglesia Evangélica Bajo Cinca!

God knows why the wait, and He has sure been working in my life and in the vision I have for this church and the expectations I have for myself. God is good, and He knows what is best! We trust in His plan and do what we can to be His hands and feet in order to serve His people here in Fraga and bring God the glory.

I want to thank you for your support, for your encouragement, and patience with us and this project. You also have been waiting to hear about some good progress here. I am trusting God that progress is coming and that He will work in mighty ways, and we will rejoice together.

Thank you for your support with helping to finance the remodel! We have been considering the space, and to make the most of what is available will have to do some demolition in the loft to expand the worship area. We would like to have about 40-45 seats, and this seems like a comfortable starting size for a church plant.

We also need to remodel the bathroom and add a second washroom and make the area handicap accessible. The front door needs to be replaced and widened. A/C, lighting, and a drop-ceiling are on the list to be able to make this a comfortable space of worship.

This modification adds an extra cost of €4K to remove one half of the loft, but will be well-worth the cost in terms of useable space for the congregation.

We are so grateful for all the help that has been extended and sacrificially given to see this church plant come to fruition.
