
Tuombe.... lets pray

-Classes...as I continue to teach the women at Crossroads
Community Church and move forward in their lessons, please
<u>PRAY</u> for all of our hearts. The women are not just my students, they are my friends and sisters-in-Christ
-Packing/moving...this is two-fold. First, I will be selling most of

my furniture/appliances to make moving easier. **PRAY** I will get fair prices so we can buy replacements on the other side.

Second, we are still looking into the best way to move my things

to Uganda. <u>**PRAY</u>** the Lord leads us to the people who are trustworthy. (we are being told the cost for just the taxes of my things will start at \$500-\$600. This does not include moving costs) We are still unclear how much the total cost of moving will be.</u> Proverbs 3:5-6 "Trust in the Lord with all your heart And do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge Him. And He will make your paths straight".



Prayer Requests next few months and beyond:



-Housing...I will have some time to look for a place once I arrive in Uganda. The Lord already answered a prayer by providing a place for me to stay for up to two months if I need, while we look at places. As we look will you please <u>PRAY</u> for good security, clean and updated, and affordable housing.

-Transition...this time of leaving Kenya and arriving in Uganda is a strange time. My thoughts are here and there and it can be a little overwhelming at times. **PRAY** my focus will be on Jesus and that I will turn to HIM in all things. I'm looking forward to learning new things and growing in my relationship with Jesus.

-Finances...we serve a God who knows all our needs and even our wants. **PRAY** for my prayers to be in line with His will and not be double-minded, and that I will seek God's wisdom in the finances we need for *moving, first*

James 1:5-8

"But if any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all generously and without reproach, and it will be given to him.  -Raising money for a car...public transportaion in Mbale is not like Kisumu. The only mode of transportation around town is boda (motorcycle) Mbale is more rural than Kisumu as well, so the need of having a personal vehicle is important.
PRAY the Lord provides a reliable vehicle, and that I will not be afraid to drive it HAHA.

-Work permit/visa: When I move to Uganda I will enter on my Kenyan work permit till February 2024 at which time my work permit will expire. I will have to re-enter

Uganda on a 3 month visitor visa. I will seek to extend that visa one time for 3 more months. When Percy and I get married I will be able to legally be in Uganda as a dependent under him. Please **PRAY** everything with immigration goes smoothly and they will allow all the extensions.
