The "girl child" is treated like an asset to be negotiated—we are told it is an appreciation to the family. Unfortunately, shame and dishonor comes when the dowry is not paid in a timely manner,

for various reasons, and then the parents threaten to take their daughter back home. How do you handle "what do I do" questions? Well, we don't talk about the controversy surrounding the dowry–but we can direct this young man to honor God. When his father-in-law sees the husband's love and respect for his daughter he is more likely to give more time for the dowry to be paid or renegotiated.

We realize that we are not here to change the culture, as much as, it is hard to hear these types of struggles—we don't change people, God does! As more and more people understand God's design for marriage, our relationship with the Lord becomes more important, and the dowry becomes less important.
