We are grateful for all the things we get to repair now before we are officially open, but I would like to have the church open.

People are still interested in the renovation. They still come by and ask me what is going up in the space, and we have a small conversation after they recover themselves from the shock—"a church!?" It is quite funny.

We expect to see some big progress happening soon in the space. The air conditioning units are in place, the drop ceiling is mostly in place, lights are almost ready to go in. We should finish with the paint, hang the doors, install the flooring, and then we can order the furniture!

I am hesitant to say this, but I am praying that we can be open by December. I

would like to advertise and hold a Christmas Eve service at our new location. I think it would be a great opportunity for people to invite their friends and family to church. Would you help us pray for that? Please pray that God would work all the missing pieces for this project so we can open the doors to the community by the first week of December. I know it will be in His time, as I said, everything that we have done now has been better to do it now than later. God knows. I just want to be done with construction work for a little bit.

In other news, a couple of weeks ago we attended a conference with the Billy Graham Association as a family. We got the chance to go and see other volunteers who are sharing the gospel online. It is always great to see them face-to-face, hear the stories of conversations they have had, and have a chance to encourage them in person.


