previously admitted at the rehabilitation home, but who have returned to drugs. This week we received a woman and only after some time did Paul recognize her. It was Patrícia, who had been with us and completed the program a few years ago. She had confessed Jesus as Savior and had left the rehabilitation home with the desire to begin a new life free from her drug addiction.



Unfortunately, because of a wrong decisions and relationships, she relapsed falling into drug use again. With tears in her eyes, she related to us of the pain and agony she experienced during the three years she had been living on the streets of Fortaleza. Patrícia was truly unrecognizable, as living in those circumstances brought much suffering and loss. Join us in prayer for the miracle of deliverance and victory in her life for God's glory.
