Together with Meela, we look forward to the opportunities of walking alongside students preparing for cross cultural missions or church planting. Initially, Meela will take a few weeks to rest from a very busy season of ministry, after which, she will serve wherever needed at the school.

Hope Community church will continue under the care of its present leadership board and the elders of our sending church - the St. Augustine Evangelical Church.

Our scheduled date of departure from Trinidad will be on July 26, 2024. Frontier School of the Bible deeply desires to keep the cost of tuition down to a significant level so that students can graduate debt free and go to the mission field faster. To do so, they require all their teachers to raise their own support to be there. We are grateful to God for your prayers, love and support and ask that you would prayerfully consider continuing your partnership with us for this new season.
