Smiling while sharing his story with me a few weeks later, he said, "I was expecting questions about hobbies, and culture, movies and stuff...,but one of the first questions someone asked me was 'Do you have peace in your life?'...I was not ready for that question." The next day, he came loaded with questions. We answered by pointing him to Jesus and to the Bible. That day, he understood the message of the gospel and the love God has for him and surrendered his life to Christ.

Since then, we continued to meet with and disciple him. It has truly been an honor to be part of what God is working in his life. All praise to the Savior! He recently moved to another city, and we have connected him with a church there where he will be able to continue to grow in his walk with the Lord. Please keep this new brother in your prayers.

The second event that is weighing on our hearts is a difficult one. In the beginning of September, our church family experienced a hard loss. A young man from our congregation passed away in a tragic accident. He leaves behind a wife and two little girls. The pain his family is going through is exceedingly great, but there is comfort in the faith he professed in Christ. We would very much appreciate it if you could pray for this family and for us as we come alongside them.

In other news regarding the church plant, we have had several people visit the church in the past month! Each of these visitors is a direct result of our congregation being bold in sharing their faith with their neighbors, friends, and relatives and inviting them to learn more about the hope that they have. Please pray that these visitors meet Jesus and desire to know more about Him.
