Son of God'!" All around the world next month, hundreds of millions of people will be remembering Jesus' death and proclaiming that He "was the Son of God". His resurrection on the third day also proved it (Rom. 1:4). May God help us all to always proclaim boldly to this sin-broken world, that Jesus is "the Son of God"!!

Puebla del Río Church. The church has continued to grow! Visitors come each month. A Colombian family who moved from Germany has been attending for the past month. Sunday attendance since Dec. is 20–25 each week (yesterday 26 of us!), Tues. night Bible Study has a consistent 6-8 people, and Thurs. night Prayer meeting usually has 10-12 of us. This encourages everyone. The church retreat in Feb. was also a great blessing!! We





had 21 church members for the weekend at camp. The guest speaker, musicians, & activity leaders

impacted everyone. The theme was "Commitment to Christ". Since no one from church had any responsibility, except to attend-enjoy-relax (Salud and I presided everything), now they all want to do another retreat!

While Arturo and Elisabet help the church a lot, he has also offended people. We've had to

moderate reconciliation several times over the past 8–10 months. Last week we met with him & the Praise team to discuss problems with him. As a result, we decided & announced that we'll ask the FIEIDE to intervene and help us find a solution for these things, and for the future of the church. Please pray for the Puebla church to keep growing, to have a good testimony for Christ with visitors, and also to develop a healthy future ministry with help from the Federation our church is in.



Other ministry. Salud has been especially busy the past 2 months with many administrative responsibilities as the Coordinator of the FIEIDE Ladies in Andalucía. She also (as secretary for the National FIEIDE Women's Department) has been getting many things ready for the annual Assembly & Congress. She and I will attend that in Valencia April 24-27th. She's also doing one-on-one discipleship with 3-4 women from the Puebla Church. I continue to teach at the Seville Theological Seminary in the MA program. This semester I'm teaching "The Reformation", that important time in the 16-17th centuries when European Christianity struggled to return to the Bible as the top authority and salvation by faith alone in Christ alone. Please keep praying for us in these different ministries!

Family news. We joyfully found out at the end of January that Jonathan, Irene and Sara are expecting a new baby!! Irene is now16-weeks pregnant. Please pray for God to help her and the baby to have a safe & healthy pregnancy. We saw them on March 2nd as I preached at their church. Salud, Elisabeth,



Julen and Nora came up from Granada, as Salud was staying with them for a week while **Sam** was in Croatia on a ministry trip. Sam is back home now. They are seeking to move to the Seville area by the summer, so Sam can start Ambassadors Football program in Seville.

Please pray that they can find affordable housing in the metroarea before June.

Finally (as I mentioned in our Dec. 2024 letter), in September this year I'll reach the age to receive my full Social Security benefit. When my benefit starts in October, it will supplement our support. So we want our churches and individual supporters to know, in case they may want to send their support (or a portion of

it) to other missions or ministries after 2025. Salud has to wait until June 2032 to get to 100% of her benefit, so we'll

keep serving full-time in ministry even after I receive my Social Security benefits. And TBM will keep receiving support for us as long as we keep serving. If any of you need more information on this, please contact me!

Thank you for praying for us, and you who support us, to serve Christ here in Spain. We thank God for you! May God bless you and help you to proclaim to everyone around you that, truly, Jesus is "the Son of God"!!
