Dear Family, Friends and Ministry Partners,

RONNIE'S RECOVERY UPDATE

After the surgery on December 20th, we returned to Trinidad on January 11. Ronnie took an additional six weeks to recover before resuming ministry duties. Meela did an excellent job caring for Ronnie. The church leadership were also careful to guard Ronnie from doing too much. He started preaching once per month, then increased it to twice per month and resumed having men's meetings and leadership meetings. Energy was slow to return but we are thankful that it is gradually coming back. Ronnie did two PSA tests since returning to Trinidad and his doctor in Miami is pleased with the reports so far (.001 & .002). His total cholesterol is also down to 120 mg/dL and his HBA1C is 5.9. We praise God for these good reports.

We met new families at the church when we returned. The ministry leaders continued with their ministry work faithfully but encountered difficulties as a team. Two of the deacons have since stepped down and we saw the need to further establish, encourage, and equip the existing leadership.
