Have you ever been on an airplane flight that instead of directly landing, had to circle around the field until some issue on the ground got resolved? That is how we have felt most of 2025. We were anxious to get on the ground and continue our work in Mbale, Uganda. But God was working His plan perfectly. He has been busy laying a new foundation here and we have been busy ministering via "zoom and WhatsApp" to several pastors and CBIT students in Mbale.

We are so excited to share much good news with you. First, we have been seeking a different sending agency that is more active in Uganda. We want to share that we were accepted by Tentmakers Bible Mission (TBM) as missionaries under their umbrella, so we are moving from Reliant to Tentmakers Bible Mission. TBM is better aligned with our philosophy and what we feel God is asking us to do in Uganda. We attended their candidate school May 5-8 earlier this year and learned on May 8th that we had been accepted. We were very thrilled with the philosophies they shared during our time with them. They celebrated 40 years in missions with a big dinner, taught several helpful classes and shared their thoughts and experiences with us throughout the week. Check out our new page here:

The new doctor Sherrie began with in March told us at the June 24th appointment that after our next appointment on August 11, we can head to Uganda. We plan to leave just after Labor Day. We appreciate your prayers that all the details will work out for us to leave. We look forward to returning to teaching pastors in the village. Please know that our relationships with many of the pastors have continued throughout our time while here in the States. We have continued to teach and mentor through WhatsApp over this year. We greatly look forward to resuming our teaching of the Bible IN PERSON!

It is very important to us that you know and believe that without the Lord using you, this work could not and would not go on! We can feel your prayers when we are there. We sense your thoughts for us. Without knowing that you are supporting us in prayer and encouragement, our life in Uganda would be very lonely.
