The next day, in the afternoon, after asking for the Lord's guidance, I felt a desire prevailed in me to go to a town about 20 minutes from us, Magnacavallo. As a young man I lived there for a few years. When I arrived I looked for an old friend whom I could not find. Later I went to another friend, Aldo. He has a store that looks like a bazaar: newspapers, vegetables, ice cream, in short, a little bit of everything. I was surprised that he was very happy to see me. As customers came he introduced them to me and agreed that I could talk to them about the Gospel and could give out Christian tracts. It was wonderful...I was able to share the Word of God with 7 to 8 people.

Last of all, a young police commander from the local police force wanted to talk to me for quite a while. At the end, he told me that one of these Sundays he'll stop by to attend one of our Sunday services! This experience made me happy!
