Church Plant Update

Cornerstone Bible Church continues to gather faithfully every Sunday in our garage. Our numbers are typically averaging around 1-4 people every Sunday. We have had a few times this summer when family and friends visited and we got up to 20 people! We are thankful for the meaningful conversations, the sound of worship in our home, and the way that God is shaping our community. We know that spiritual growth isn't measured only in numbers, and we trust that God is at work even now.





We've been actively searching for a new space for Sunday services and Bible studies. We are hoping to find somewhere that is visible and public, as we feel that meeting in our home can be intimidating to new people wanting to check out the church. Several locations along Main Street showed promise, but they were either not move-in ready, or far beyond our financial capacity at this time. The search continues, and we'd love your prayers for God's provision of an affordable, welcoming space in our community.

We have also been looking at some outreach opportunities in the area, specifically we are planning on doing a neighborhood barbecue on Saturday. We plan to have hot dogs and lawn games and try to get people out to see the church and meet us. We are still in the beginning stages of planning this outreach so please pray for us in the planning and marketing.





What We're Studying

In our Sunday services, we're currently journeying through the Book of Acts. It's been an incredible reminder that God uses ordinary people to build His extraordinary church. In our weekly Bible study that meets every Wednesday, we just finished the book of James and have moved on to 1 Peter. We've been discussing what it means to live as elect exiles in the world. These times of study and fellowship have been rich and refining, and we're grateful for the spiritual hunger we're seeing in those who attend.


