1 Timothy 6:3-4a (NASB) says: "If anyone advocates a different doctrine and does not agree with sound words, those of our Lord Jesus Christ, and the doctrine

conforming to godliness, he is conceited and understands nothing". For Aug.-Sept. I'm preaching on "Godliness in the Christian life", teaching "the doctrine conforming to godliness" in the "sound words of our Lord Jesus Christ". We're ordered: "discipline yourself for the purpose of godliness" (4:7). It's also about who Jesus is and what He did (3:16 – "the mystery of godliness" summarizes Jesus' life and work). Puebla del Río Church. In summer (July & August) we only have Sunday worship services and Thursday prayer meetings. All other activities (Bible study, home cell group, men's and women's meetings) are put on hold. The heat makes it hard for our elderly, or those who walk to church here, as the temperatures go over 100°F for days in a row. This summer was the 3rd longest heat wave of the past 100 years, with 16 days of 100-110°F. Many church folk take a Sunday to go to the beach (60 mi. west of us). Some take vacation time in July-August, so attendance drops to 15-18 on Sundays, and 6-10 on Thursdays. We know attendance isn't the only measure of the church's spiritual health, but it does help us all to see the level of

commitment of the church to faithfully proclaim the Gospel to the town.

On June 29th was the business meeting to tell church members that Arturo is no longer a pastoral candidate or elder. His


last Sunday to preach was July 6th. The church paid his full July salary and a severance pay of 2 months (which the law required for 3-vrs of part-time work). He, Elisabeth and their daughter still attend while they look for a place to go. So the church is in a new transition. Four of the men are in a leadership team with me (see 3 in photo). They help preside the Sunday and Thursday services, give devotionals at Prayer meeting, and even preach a little. Please thank God for helping the Puebla church to reorganize in a new transition, & praise Him for the members who are coming alongside to serve.



Other ministry. We have a busy fall semester ahead!! Oct. 4th, Salud and I will go to Córdoba for the Andalucía FIEIDE Churches Annual meeting (she's the Women's Coordinator and I'm a Board member). And, Salud will work the Annual FIEDE Andalucía Ladies' Retreat Nov. 14-16th, near Málaga with about 200 women. As for me, on Sept. 27th near Seville, Oct.24-25th & Nov. 21-22nd near Málaga, **I'll** teach in Expository preaching workshops. And on Nov. 14-16, I'll teach an Expository preaching workshop and preach in a church in Mallorca. It will be my 1st visit to the Balearic Islands in my 38 yrs in Spain! Lord willing on Sept. 22nd, I start teaching at the Seville Theological Seminary, with a history class on Spanish Christianity before the Reformation. It will be a busy fall for us!! Please pray for us in these different ministries, and for our health and stamina to keep up with all of it!

Family news. On Aug. 27th, Sylvia was born! (see photos) What a huge blessing for Jonathan, Irene and Sara to have a new member of the family-and for us too! Please thank God for giving Irene & the baby a safe pregnancy, & pray for them to recover well from the delivery and for all the family to adapt well to the new situation at home.
