She also has tried a few solids here and there, (loving avocado, egg yolk, and especially steak, while having much less of an appetite for applesauce, banana, and sardines). Over Christmas we were able to take her to the zoo with my sisters and nephews which was also a blast. Maria even got to feed a giraffe! In the last two months specifically, we have been able to make big moves towards Peru. As I mentioned previously, we were able to get Maria's birth certificate, have an appointment for her passport, have an appointment to apostille our marriage license, got an FBI background check done and apostilled, ordered suit cases, and bought tickets! The three of us will head down to Tarapoto on March 24th. We currently have around 70% of our monthly support raised and are so excited to get down there!

We have one more month left here in the States, and we are hoping to take advantage of every minute! In March we will be visiting one last church in Nebraska, where we will also have the opportunity to stay and visit with both family and friends. As we near the date of our move we also have other family traveling to visit us before we go. We will be sad to leave our loved ones but are also looking forward to the ministry that is before us in Peru!
