Can you believe it's already the end of the first quarter of 2026? Time certainly flies both when you're having fun and when you're keeping busy.



#### Ministry with TBM @ Frontier School of the Bible.

We arrived in LaGrange Wyoming on January 2 to take up our responsibilities with Tentmakers Bible Mission as Campus Representatives at Frontier School of the Bible. Meela initially

struggled with her asthma due to the high winds and lots of allergens being stirred up in the air. However, she finally got relief after about 6 weeks as the doctors eventually figured out what medicines she needed to take daily.

Classes at FSB started on January 12. Ronnie is teaching 3 classes: *Victorious Christian Living* to the freshman

class (92 students), *Hebrews* to the Junior class (57 students) and co-teaching *Church Planting* to the senior class (34 students). He also mentors 3 young men every Friday afternoon and leads a prayer group of six young men every other week.

We are very thankful for the leadership at TBM & FSB. What an opportunity the Lord has given to us to be part of this amazing family as we train the next generation of missionaries, pastors and church planters.

### SPRING BREAK TRIPS



Visit to Valley of Fire Mesquite NV.

This spring break we had the opportunity to speak at two churches - River Valley Bible Church in Mesquite, Nevada

and Kersey Community Church in Kersey, Colorado. Both opportunities were fruitful for the Gospel. There were at least 12 people who indicated they were putting their faith in Christ in Mesquite NV and about 15 people in Kersey CO.

They will be visiting 5 camps and ministering to teenagers. She is very excited about this and is also seeking the Lord for what her next step will be after graduation next year. She too, has an interest in missions but is asking the Lord for clarity as to where and what that will be.

**Ronnie and Meela** - We are doing well overall with Ronnie continuing to enjoy good health post his cancer surgery in December 2025. His PSA continues to be undetectable, and he will repeat this test again when we return to Trinidad in May.

The plan is to be in Trinidad until the end of July and then head back to Wyoming for the start of the Fall semester 2026.
