

April 2026 Prayer Letter

Dear Friends,

I hope you had a great Easter with your family and friends. We were privileged to have Maddy's parents with us this Easter. They took us on a family vacation, and it was a lot of fun for everybody.

We celebrated Palm Sunday with an all-church meal at our house. It ended up being very windy, so we had to improvise cooking and eating inside the house rather than outside as we had hoped. We squeezed thirty people into our living room, and it was a great family meal with lots of conversation and encouragement. I believe we may have broken the attendance record for our church on Palm Sunday and Easter Sunday. People from our church invited their friends and family, and they heard and saw the gospel both from the pulpit and from interactions with our church family.

We are still working on our discipleship strategy, not trying to develop anything new, just looking for *F.A.T.* people (you know: Faithful, Available and Teachable). This year, we have seen new people come and some people leave again for different reasons. We continue to build on those who stay and challenge them to multiply. One lady, Beatriz, a theology professor living here in Fraga, is serving with Maddy in worship and Sunday school. She has a desire to disciple another lady within the congregation or outside the church.

Alberto has also been a great help. He has grown so much in the Lord since we first met. He has stepped up in service and leadership. He consistently serves on Sunday

morning and is also looking for a man to disciple. I have had a few attempts at discipling people this year, but the people I was working with lost interest or got too busy to meet. I do consistently meet with a man named Fernando, and we pray for God's guidance in his life.

We have an evangelistic opportunity coming up in May. A team of professors and student musicians are touring through the north of Spain/south of France and they are coming to Fraga. The city hall has approved our request to use the Castle, which is a very nice setting for an evening concert. We will work on the details and tell you about it soon, but this will be a great opportunity to continue connecting with people from our community with the gospel. The musicians will connect the music with the beauty of the Scriptures, they will share the gospel, and we will have time before and after to interact with people who attend the event. We look forward to it!
